

## Portfolio Project Get Feedback

In advance of sharing your portfolio, you may want to ask others to review your progress. Use this worksheet to solicit feedback from professors, peer mentors, colleagues, advisors, family, or friends. Before they complete this worksheet, you may need to describe your intended audience or share contextual information regarding your site objectives in order to help your reviewer provide useful feedback – e.g. is this a course- or program-based portfolio? is the intended audience prospective employers?

### 1. First Impressions

Describe your first impressions of the site creator based on their portfolio. What contributes to this impression? Give specific examples.

### 2. Communication

Did the creator include a variety of artifacts to communicate their overall message or objective(s)? Are their artifacts appropriate? Is their text grammatically correct and error-free?

### 3. Reflection

Do you understand why the creator selected these documents or media? Does their tone demonstrate both professionalism and personality? Are the pages organized in a way that makes sense?

#### 4. User Experience

Do all links, pages, and technical features work correctly? Are copyrighted materials (including images) attributed correctly?

#### 5. Design

Are the colours, fonts, and layout visually appealing and consistent across pages? Is the design appropriate? Do the images and other visual features contribute to overall site objectives?

#### 6. Final Comments

How might the site creator improve or strengthen their portfolio for the intended audience or objective?
